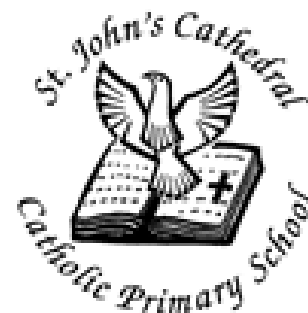

If you are one of these parents then please sit at the very back of the Cathedral so that you can easily take your child outside if they make a noise.

## **School Uniform**
